PLAYER AGREEMENT

I agree to:

- Treat coaches, teammates, opponents, referees and spectators with courtesy and respect.
- Play fairly and with good sportsmanship.
- Accept the decisions of referees without gesture or argument.
- Control my temper and not use inappropriate, derogatory or vulgar language.
- Never criticize the play of others and never blame others for my mistakes.
- Follow the instructions of my coach without argument. (i.e. playing time and position).
- Work hard, concentrate, cooperate and not be disruptive in practices and games.
- Play my part in arriving on time to practices and games.
- Obey any team rules the coach or league puts in place.
- Maintain a positive environment.

PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT

I understand that:

- The organization policy is that use of alcohol and tobacco products by parents and other spectators is not allowed at games and practices.

I agree to:

- Encourage a positive environment for both teams.
- Encourage my child to be the best team player that he or she can be.
- Not coach or give instructions to the players including my own child during games and practices.
- Never openly express criticism for players or coaches of either team or referees during a game.
- Never confront the coach or team manager with emotional issues in front of the players.
- Never use inappropriate language during a game or practice.
- Ensure my child has a responsible adult with them at all games and practices in case of injury.
- Ensure my child has the means to arrive and be picked up on time for practices and games.
- Never leave an un-enrolled children unsupervised at practices and games.
- Follow the rule of NO eating or drinking in the gym at all times.
- Allow my child's photograph to appear on the E.B.Y.B.A. website, not for publication.

VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN: Any violation of the above mentioned items shall result in a warning being issued to any coach, player or spectator by the referee, head coach, league coordinator or league president. The E.B.Y.B.A. league president shall be notified, the incident recorded and the individual(s) who have been issued the second warning will be asked to leave the gym and not be allowed to attend any more games for the rest of the season. Once a person has been ejected from the gym they will not be allowed back into the gym. If they re-enter the gym and refuse to leave, their team may be forced to forfeit the game and/or the police will be called to escort that person out of the gym. This zero tolerance policy is designed to ensure a positive basketball experience for all people attending the game.
